# **FOLLOW SAFE CLUBS GUIDELINES**

- · Look up your Child Protection Policy.
- Create positive environments for children.
- The rule of 2 avoid 1:1 time with children. For example adults supervise in pairs in changing rooms etc.
- Follow the Overnight and Travel Guidelines.
- Explain, ask and get permission when correcting technique.



### LOOK OUT FOR SIGNS OF ABUSE

- In children: Injuries, behaviour and play that causes concern should not be ignored.
- In adults: It is ok to ask questions if you see threatening behaviour, overstepping children's personal boundaries and giving gifts or money for no reason.


